

Just Horsin' Round Budget Friendly Horse Show Circuit

2017

Rules and Regulations

The Just Horsin' Round Budget Friendly Circuit consists of three 2-day shows. The dates are April 22-23, June 17-18, and August 12-13, 2017.

You must show all three weekends (one day out of each weekend will qualify) to be eligible for a year end award. The same back number must stay with the horse for all three shows for the points to count. Nominations for the JHR Circuit Year End Awards must be made on the Entry Form and paid for BEFORE POINTS WILL BE COUNTED. (Example: Before the horse has been shown). Nominations are \$10 per division.

A NEGATIVE COGGINS (within 12 months) is required by North Carolina State Law. The coggins will be checked upon arrival and a copy must be hung on the stall door. No horse will be allowed on the show grounds without a negative coggins.

SPECIFIC RULES FOR THE FOLLOWING CLASS DIVISIONS:

- **Saddle Seat Classes**-Martingales are allowed in all classes except the WTC classes. Martingales are allowed in Junior Classes. May not cross enter into Saddle Pleasure.
- ****Classes**-Open to ASB Mares and Geldings – plain shod without bands, pads, bars or attachments. **Western Pleasure Classes** are to be shown at the flat walk, jog-trot and lope both ways of the ring. Will be asked to back on the rail. **Hunt Seat** Classes are to be shown at the flat walk, trot, extended trot, canter and hand gallop both ways of the ring. Will be asked to back on the rail.
- **ASB Designated Classes**-must be shown according to USEF Rules.
- **Training Classes**-Training equipment allowed. No tie downs.
- **Novice Classes**-Exhibitor may not have won 3 first place ribbons in any show in any particular seat.

- **Green Horse Classes**-Open to inexperienced horses in the first year of showing in a particular seat.
- **Junior Horse Classes**-5 years and under.
- **Youth Rider Classes**-18 and under as of January 1, 2017.
- **Working Western Classes**-Cannot cross enter into Western Pleasure. Horses should be of a natural working type with a free flowing stride.
- **Field Hunter Classes**-Cannot cross enter into Hunt Seat. Horses should have a way of going that is proper for horses going over fences. Shown on the flat.
- **Halter Classes**-Open to horses and ponies. PERFORMANCE HALTER will be judged on conformation and movement that is correct for a performance horse. Open to any breed.
- **Ladies Classes**-Open to any age.
- **Saddle Type Classes**-Open to breeds such as Arabians, Morgans, Saddlebreds, Thoroughbreds, Walking and Racking horses. Must be plain shod. Open to all tack types except where specified. No Stock Type entries. May not cross enter into the Saddle Seat Division.
- **Pony Classes**-14.2 hands and under.
- **Any GAYP Class**-Must show at the same GAYP gait both ways of the ring.
- **Draft Type**-Open to light and heavy draft breeds including but not limited to Friesian, Gypsy Vanner, Halflinger, Shire, Belgian, Clydesdale and Percheron. Exhibitors will enter the ring at a trot/jog.
- **WALK ONLY**-Any age, never shown before. Cannot enter any other class. May be accompanied by an attendant. May use a lead line IF NECESSARY. May enter the Lead Line Class.
- **NO ENTRIES ACCEPTED WITHOUT AN OPEN CHECK OR CASH PAYMENT.**
